I wanted to finish *Haunt* right before *Cease*, the finale, gets released. *Forsaken MC*—the brothers and their ol ladies—have been such a big part of my book world for the past few years, and I'm truly sad that soon it'll all be over.

This is Wyatt and Amber's story, yet it felt like the book belonged to Amber. Of course, there was plenty of male goodness around, but the last word seemed to come from the women of *Forsaken*.

Amber was born into club life so I understood her concern for her children's safety, considering the nature of their lifestyle and the danger that comes with it. Amber also kept the kids away from Wyatt, who was heavily using drugs and spiraling down a pretty dangerous path himself. No matter how much time and space they spent apart, these two never stopped loving each other.

After Amber returned for good, she and a clean Wyatt took their place as the Prez and his queen of the MC. As Wyatt reconnected with his kids, it felt like he was finally at peace with himself and realized the enormous responsibility Amber held on her own.
