This novella features Lydia, a very popular Domme, do popular that even though the club she works at is not the nicest she has drawn national notoriety by word of mouth from visitors. Lydia has generated enough notoriety she has begun to effect the business of one of the best clubs "El Diablo" and in doing so, garnered the attention of its very sexy Dom and owner of "El Diablo" Damien Collins. Damien, wants Lydia for his club; and once he sees her handling her twelve foot bull whip, he wants her for himself. Damien has arranged with Lydia's current employer for her to work for him in Houston for a month, without her knowledge, he just strolled in and took what he wanted, and it does not sit well with her. One night Damian Collins, the sexy owner of upmarket BDSM club, El Diablo, walks into Lydia's club with an offer to come and work for him. Lydia declines, but she can't help the way her body reacts to Damian, and it freaks her out. Not taking 'no' for an answer, Damian gets her to work at his club anyway, through a wager he wins.

This was a great premise for a story, but I feel it wasn't executed as well as it could have been. If the author had doubled the content of the book, we would have gotten a better feel for Lydia and Damian. And the ending was unbelievably rushed.
