The problem for me is that the book is written entirely in first person from Kate but, and this I think is due to the YA feel of it, she is so under-developed that the book especially the dialogue of the characters falls really flat. The book should really be full of emotional trauma, tension and suspense but the characters are so lacking that it really can't be saved. Additionally, realising that I'm really writing this book off, the superpowers of the twins are not really being used for anything useful?
