I'm really having a hard time deciding what I actually thought about this book. I have read and thoroughly enjoyed the first couple of novels and some of the shorts in Ms Rowse's Klondike Era mystery series and I intend to read the rest of that series so I wanted to try the contemporary series but I was somewhat disappointed by this book. I think my biggest problem was that I found the book to be very slow with really no action and far too many characters who all seemed like Brian's probable father and I couldn't keep track of them at all. Much too much of this story is told by tell not show in all of Barbara's internal monologues which seem to take up the vast majority of this novel and frankly became quite boring. Nothing really seems to happen until the last 4 chapters and then the ending happens with much too much of a rush. There is still much to like about this story as the character development is pretty solid and the descriptions of the settings and weather are superb. There are a few proofreading errors one of which is pretty blatant and should never have slipped by a proofreader/editor. Throughout the whole book Cassie, Brian and Joe are all named "Stewart" until in Chapter 22 we find this - "the Stuart case, to". The other errors are extra words in a sentence such as in Chapter 28 - "needed to know OUT more about the circumstances of her son's birth" and in Chapter 31 - "Why were you WERE the first person Brian came to see".

I'll quite possibly try the next in the series if I can obtain it cheap enough to see if my problems with this book are specific to this story but it won't have a high priority on my TBR list.
