Space Lords, and His Frost Maiden, is another series related to the Dragon Lords and Lords of the Var series, but one thing I couldn't help but enjoy was the more varied sci-fi elements in the book. Whereas the other two series are set on planet, His Frost Maiden was set more in space and I very much enjoyed that.

His Frost Maiden is set after the Lords of the Var series (which I haven't actually finished yet) so some things were revealed that I hadn't yet known about, but I didn't think that that was really a problem! I enjoyed meeting Lochlann and Jarek, both of whom had been mentioned in previous books but I hadn't yet met!

I really liked Josselyn as a character. Despite the fact that her society was (purposefully) based on medieval Earth, she seemed to have grown up as an equal to the men around her and could hold her own. She also had a good grasp on the politics around her. I liked the fact that her and Evan felt like equals from the beginning!

The relationship between Evan and Josselyn was fairly slow burning. They admitted their attraction for each other from the beginning, and even acted on it fairly quickly (well after a few weeks anyway) but admitting that they cared for each other came a lot later on.

I loved reading about the crew and the other characters in His Frost Maiden, and am excited to find out more in future books!

I have been reading Michelle Pillow's work for a while and I so enjoy her stories. In this series Space Lords we meet a crew of misfits. Banded together, in a functioning dysfunctional family. It works for them. Evan is an empath that is on this crew of men. He is troubled by his past failures, specifically not taking care of his sister. The writing was solid but there were some phrases that I had to read twice as they were poorly constructed. The sci-fi was interesting, but a bit jumbled. The family story was solid, probably the best part of the book. The sex was minimal.

Evan Cormier has the gift of empathy. He guards himself closely so he doesn't get unduly influenced by others. When he meets Josselyn Craven he is unable to shield himself from her and soon finds he doesn't want to.

Since the first book where Evan is introduced in The Bound Prince I have wanted to read his story. Then he

gets cursed, along with the rest of the crew, by a spirit in The Pirate Prince and I wanted to read about him even more. He is quiet, unassuming, always the peacemaker, and more internal than many of the rest of the crew. There aren't many conversations between him and Josselyn since he feels her emotions so strongly but when they are together he just can't help himself. Josselyn has such a sad back story that is told in the prologue and it will break your heart. Not to spoil anything but her planet was more old fashioned than most so she doesn't really understand the ways of the galaxy.

As I have said on almost every review of these connected series of Pillow's, the description of the worlds is phenomenal. When I was reading about Josselyn's home planet I could see it clearly in my mind. With each new series, the planets and customs of the characters keep changing making them all fresh and excited. With the main characters of this series living on a space craft, I am expecting each one to have new exciting planets and creatures that are distinct to each book.

I really enjoyed this book. Evan and Josselyn were very internal characters but they are great together. Towards the end Josselyn is faced with several tough choices and teared up at how heart-wrenching her situation had become. It is a great start to the series and I was so happy to be on The Conqueror again. We get to see Jarek and Mei again from The Pirate Prince as well the expected interaction of the rest of the crew. If you haven't read the previous series you will not be lost. Each book works as a stand alone. However, as I mentioned, some of the characters were first mentioned in other books and/or have their own book. I am very excited to see where the series goes from here and who the next crew mate to meet his match will be.
