Men have often been considered as being the more audacious sex, going off adventuring, heroing, fighting, exploring or pillaging and looting while the ladies stay in one place tending the home fires. Most of those activities don't exist today, so your modern thrill-seeking male often substitutes activity like canoeing, parachuting out of planes or, in Seth Bolton's case, setting up businesses in foreign countries.

So he's a wanderer, babe, and that's the way he wants it. He wants to float from town to town or woman to woman and he's not going to be tied down for anybody. Of course, he says this right up front. Such men claim that they do it to be honest. (Sounds like they're preparing an escape route, if you ask me.)

Into Seth's restless life comes a run-away pregnant would-be bride, one Kate Burroughs. Kate got itchy feet at the altar because she decided her fiancé was a bit of a toad. When Roger makes his one appearance in the novel, we can't help but agree. He's indifferent to her pregnancy except to make aborted statements about the change in her appearance, he doesn't want to provide child-care and he accuses her of being a bitch when

she tells him to hit the road. Ouch.

But all that happens after Seth and Kate have their meet-cute moment. She's still wearing her bridal gown and he has to get off the complicated affair before she can sit on his motorcycle. All the while he's undoing her clothing, all sorts of inappropriate thoughts are going through his head, mostly about how he wants to see her naked without that annoying dress, her face free of makeup or her hair loose without her elaborate coiffure. In short, she's hot but only if she conforms to his idea of prettiness.

However, all the initial prickle of discomfort gets swept aside when Seth decides to buy a house to set up a home base for his bike business. Kate is a real estate agent and he's eager to throw business her way...and quite a bit more. He asks to take her to dinner, an offer that leaves her a little wary. Her gonads have been jumping ever since she met him and she's been putting it down to pregnancy hormones. So she really doesn't want to take him up on his offer, especially since he makes it clear that he's only in town for a short while. She's not the girl for casual flings and that's all he's offering. Sex, fun, no strings, just a roll in the hay and I'm gone, baby.

Kate wants to say no (listen to that voice, girl!) but she weakens easily under Seth's hot good looks and his promise that they'd be good together (in bed). Frankly, I thought she'd be more concerned about how bad this looks professionally. She's trying to sell him a house. He's said no to some properties, is hesitating about others and yet he's asking that they have sex together. Doesn't she see how sleazy this looks? It's as if she's sleeping with him in the hope that he'll buy and give her a commission!

Of course, no one in the book ever breathes the suggestion that she's boning him to get a big, fat commission. She's desperate enough. She really needs the money for herself and her unborn child but we're never meant to put that spin on her actions. He actually gives her expensive diamond pendant and earrings worth \$50,000, just like a man might give a mistress. Yet she's just getting it on with him because he's smoking, she's lovely and lonely and they'd both have a good time, so why not?

Seth has to wrestle with his yearning to travel and leave behind the darling Kate. Given the need for a HEA ending, we know he's going to stay. This is fantasy of the romantic kind and considerations like professional behavior are easily waved aside in favor of bringing our blushing lady and lusty male together. I like Kate and I like Seth. I just can't condone the situation that forms the basis for their relationship. May this romance fall into the hands of those uncritical enough to forgive a sheer lack of on-the-job professionalism.
