Really interesting tale in the Contact series. I enjoyed this more than the first outing with Lore because of the extra depth to the relationship.

The author captures the characters thoughts and brings them to life. The scenes are painted clearly without fuss and overwordiness. Even the sweetness isn't too sickly.

We join Deminic pondering whats missing in his overachievers life and how the subs on the scene hold no challenge. I was pretty neutral about this guy until we see how he reacts to his first encounter with Blade.

The opening scene with Blade had my heart pounding as we find our protag strapped naked over a bench, ass in the air, ready lubed against his will.

The Blade/Demic dynamic works very well and I like the first tentative exploration into BDSM.

Unlike the first book, where I wasn't really caught up with wanting to know what came next, these characters have made a place in my head/heart. I want to follow their story further. I want to find out more about minor character Alfonsea.

There is a little more world building in the first one, background into Blade's situation otherwise I would say this was a stand alone.

It definitely a book I will pick up again and I'll happily read the next in the series,

This is the second volume in Jade Archer's "Contact" series - and was just as good as the first. It's a stand alone story with only a few references to the previous volume, but is set in the same future "world". We find out a few more details about the somewhat mysterious (and definitely) cruel Mebians, which fills out the picture nicely.

Like the first book, the limited number of pages didn't take away from my enjoyment. The characters were fun, I felt for both of them from the very start and there was a nice twist at the end. This was more focused on the elements of dominance and submission, but in a very loving context.

Deminic is a great guy - if somewhat bored and desperate for someone to love. He may not admit this in the beginning, but when he meets Blade and sees the potential, he doesn't hesitate. I loved his ability to sense what was going on with Blade and his willingness to compromise, so they could find out what worked for both of them.

Blade was also a great character. The conflict between being a slave (having sold himself into servitude to get training as an engineer) and suddenly discovering that he wanted to be dominated was a difficult process for him. He is bratty, yes, but only because he has no idea how to deal with the situation his master has put him in.

I loved this book and can't wait for the next volume. There was a tantalizing teaser about one of the secondary characters at the end which lets me hope there will be a third book in the series.
